Qualifying / Practice Day – 20th April 2024

Motor Cycle Competitors - should report to the Chief Paddock Marshal by 6.00am and ensure that the Motor Cycle is Scrutinized and ready <u>for free</u> <u>Practice</u>.

Motor Car Competitors – should report to the Chief Paddock Marshal by 6.30am and ensure that the Car is Scrutinized and ready for Practice / Qualifying.

Race Day – 21st April 2024

All Competitors should report to the Chief Paddock Marshal by 6.30am

<u>All competitors</u> should <u>Sign the Attendance Register</u> placed at the Chief Paddock Marshals Office on both days.

<u>**Competitor Briefing**</u> (Compulsory attendance all competitors) will be held at 7.30am on 20th April (Practice / qualifying day) at the Chief Paddock Marshal's Office.

It is highly Recommended that all competitors familiarize the track and the conditions by doing a "Track Walk" before the briefing.

Paddock Allocation and Parking of Support Vehicles

All competitors are pre allocated with a Paddock slot which will be numbered. You should ensure that your competition vehicle should be parked in the allotted slot along with your support vehicle.

Competitors who are using Car Carriers have to unload their competition vehicle at the "Crest Hill" Area and drive to the paddock hill. VEHICLE CARRIERS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE PADDOCK HILL.

Entry Passes

Vehicle passes should be prominently displayed on the Top Left corner of the front Windscreen and any vehicle not possessing a vehicle pass will not be permitted to the Paddock hill area.

Competitors and Support Crew should have the valid passes at all times to enter and remain at the paddock hill area and always co-operate with the Sri Lanka Military Academy officers at entry points.

Competitor Numbers

Motor Bikes – A set consisting of 3 numbers will issued for each entry and same should be displayed at the designated area as per the rules.

Motor Cars – A set consisting of 5 numbers will be issued for each entry and same should be displayed as follows;

Bonnet (Front Left), Both Front Doors, Front Windscreen (Top Left), Rear Windscreen (Top Left)

PA Announcements

All Competitors / Team Managers / Pit Crew should pay attention to the Public Address System announcements at all times. Failure to report to the dummy grid on time for qualifying / Race will result in the competitor/s getting excluded from the event.

Grid Positions & Maximum number of Starters

In the event of the starters exceeding 15 for a race, the following decision will be taken by the stewards of the meet.

The Competitors within 107% of the 3^{rd} fastest time of the particular event will be qualified to race or the fastest 15 competitors will be qualified to race and / or the Stewards decision will be final on the above.

Podium Ceremony

At the end of every race, the 1st three or 1st five positions will be awarded trophies. The Results will remain provisional until the official protest time is completed. The winners will be directed to the Podium and they should proceed to the podium at reduced speed in a safe manner and follow the instructions of the Marshals at the start line area.

Once the awards are received, the winners should proceed to the paddocks under the instructions of the marshals in a safe manner. <u>All cars should be</u> weighed before entering your personal paddock area.

Any Car competitor who has not weighed before entering the personal paddock area will be disqualified from the race,
